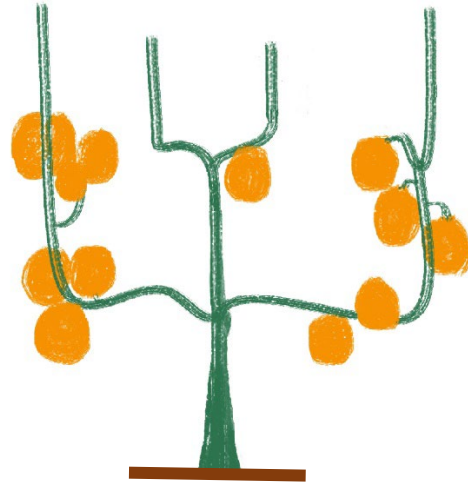


Come and celebrate the art of espalier

25-26 January and 21-22 June 2025

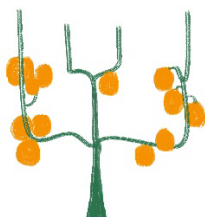

By espaliers, we mean fruit trees trellised on a wall (espaliers stricto sensu) and also against a structure and also small volume forms.
